REAL ID Enforcement: Alaska Homeland Security

Secure driver's licenses and identification documents are a vital component of a holistic national security strategy. Law enforcement must be able to rely on government-issued identification documents and know that the bearer of such a document is who he or she claims to be. REAL ID is a coordinated effort by the states and the Federal Government to improve the reliability and accuracy of state-issued identification documents, which should inhibit terrorists’ ability to evade detection by using fraudulent identification.

Alaska has an **extension** for REAL ID enforcement, allowing Federal agencies to accept driver's licenses and identification cards from **Alaska** at Federal facilities, nuclear power plants and federally regulated commercial aircraft until October 10, 2018.

The Alaska State Archery Association 5 Spot indoor tournament on February 17th & 18th was a great success. Thanks to all the shooters and those who helped with score keeping.

The Great Alaskan Sportsman's Show will be held on April 5 – 8. We are planning to run the archery range again in 2018. Bernie will relay our interest when he is contacted. A signup sheet has been posted at the indoor range to recruit help for this event. Please try to find a time slot to help out on this worthwhile event. You can sign up at the range, or contact Pam or Bernie to find out times needed and to sign up. Don't forget, you get free access to the Sportsman's show when you work a shift. Parking is on your own and we recommend you use one of the shuttles available.
