JANUARY BUSINESS MEETING

OLD BUSINESS:

The Northwest Indoor sectionals will be held on March 2 and 3, 2019. This is the only weekend available due to the state 5 spot shoot being held the weekend before. The Black Sheep will host one time slot in addition to other locations around the state. The times for the shoot will be at 2:00 pm and signup will be at 1:00 pm. Sign up sheets are posted for the State 3 spot, State 5 spot and the Northwest Sectionals. There will be sign up sheets for shooters and for scorekeepers. This is an excellent way to complete a work party by signing up to be a scorekeeper.

Election of officers is held during the first meeting in January. Chris Jones made a motion to retain the current officers in their positions. Daniel seconded the motion. Marsha moved that nominations close. Diana Lopez seconded the motion. All were in favor.

The inserts for the 3D targets have been ordered, received and Ryan has been reimbursed. Thank you Ryan for following up with this project.

The TV to view the various camera shots still needs to be mounted. Daniel and Evan are still working on this.

It is time to review and resubmit our constitution. It is available on the website and anyone with any comments or suggestions, please let Pam know. Pam has reviewed the document and suggested some minor changes. She will make the changes and bring them to the February meeting for final approval.

NEW BUSINESS:

The State indoor 3 spot tournament will be held on February 2nd and 3rd at the indoor range. Signup will be at 11:00 am and the shoot will start at noon on both days.

The State indoor 5 spot tournament will be held on February 23rd and 24th at the indoor range. Signup will be at 1:00 pm and the shoot will start at 2:00 pm on both days.

The Northwest Section indoor tournament will be held on March 2nd and 3rd at the indoor range. Signup will be at 1:00 pm and the shoot will start at 2:00 pm on both days. Sign up sheets are posted on the board for all 3 shoots for shooters and score keepers. Space is limited, so please sign up early.

Daniel informed us that he will be leaving the state in the near future so we will need to look for another indoor range master. Anyone interested in this position please contact Bernie or Jake and let them know..

Daniel moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:35. Chris seconded the motion. The next meeting will be held on Thursday, February 7 at 7:00 pm at the indoor range.

INDOOR RANGE MASTER REPORT:

The indoor spot league will begin on Saturday, January 12 at the indoor range and continue through March as long as there is interest. The start time has been moved to 6:00 pm. The cost is \$5 per person per week. Cubs shoot free.

The bow press is still needing a replacement bolt. Follow up is begin completed and an order will be placed.

The snow and thaw have not resulted in any water on the floor yet. Keeping snow away from the outside door must continue to be a priority this winter so that we are in compliance with the fire codes.

The monthly fire extinguisher inspection will be completed by Daniel at the end of the meeting.

OUTDOOR RANGE MASTER REPORT:

No work parties are planned at this time.

The roads to the outdoor range are passable. There is a berm closing off the driveway to the range. Targets appear to be in good condition. Please use caution when driving these back roads as maintenance is not consistent and roads can be icy and the curves treacherous. Also be aware of the posted speed limits.
